## RECENT POLICY HIGHLIGHTS

- Dept. of Energy sided with AWE in proposing to reverse weakened water efficiency standards
- Bi-partisan infrastructure bill passed U.S. Senate with \$400M (over 5 years) in new funding for western states water efficiency (Water Smart grants)
  - AWE sign-on letter sent to congressional leaders
  - Promising meeting with White House about additional/national funding
- Optimistic about passing federal legislation to make water conservation rebates tax-free
- House Committee approved legislation with funding for the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) to research how premise plumbing should be designed and maintained in light of lower water flows.



### RECENT PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Launched new verification program for updated G-480-20 Water Conservation and Efficiency Program Operation and Management Standard
  - Webinar held Thursday, August 26, 2021
- Presented at AWWA's ACE conference on AWE's Detroit water affordability analysis
- Reached agreement to offer a 10% discount to AWE members for Conserve Track software
- "Water Saving Tips" added to AWE website navigation menu
- 14 applications received for next round of *Learning Landscapes* grants; 5 grantees selected







