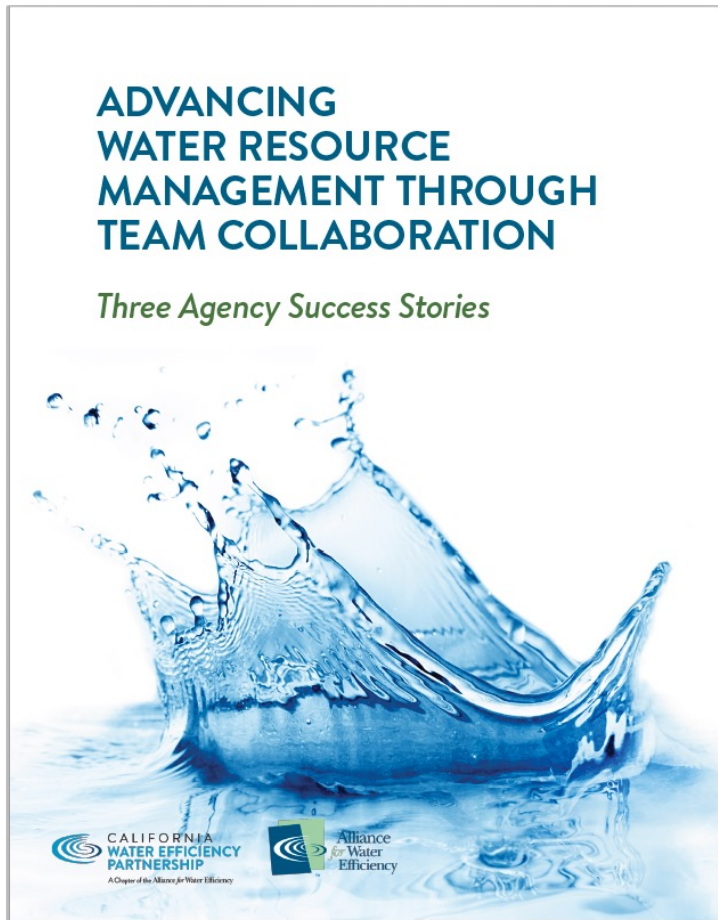

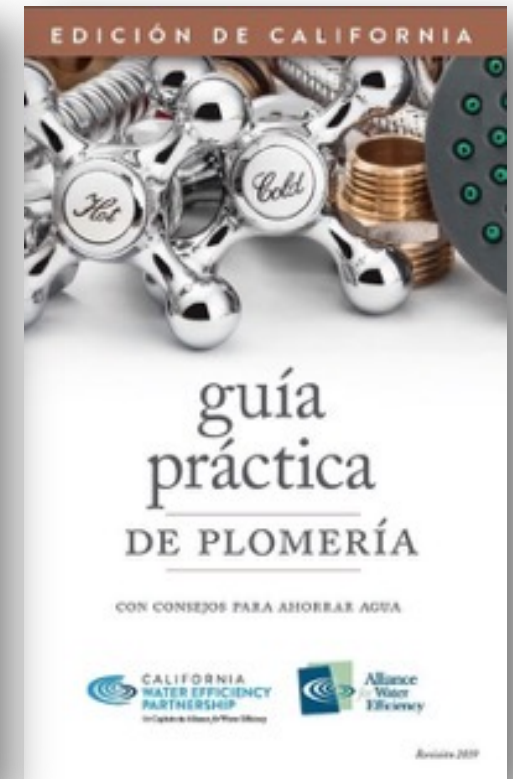
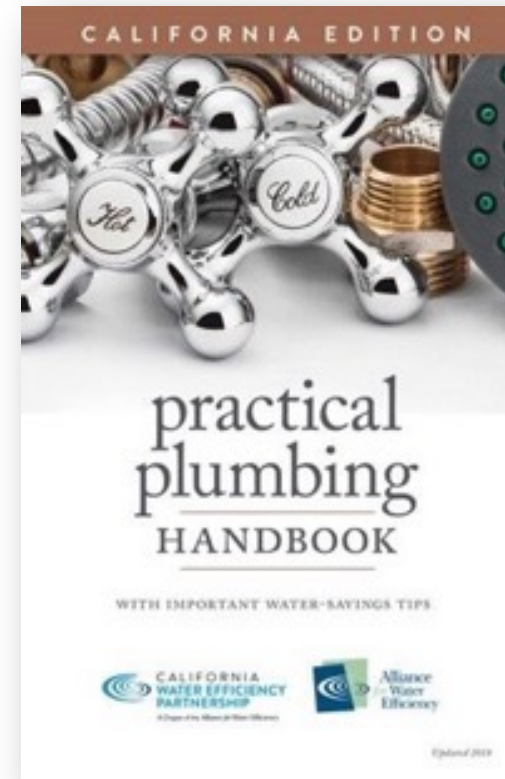
# Practical Plumbing Handbook

# Advocacy Report



## **Assembly Bill 2142 (Gabriel): Tax Exclusion for Turf Replacement**

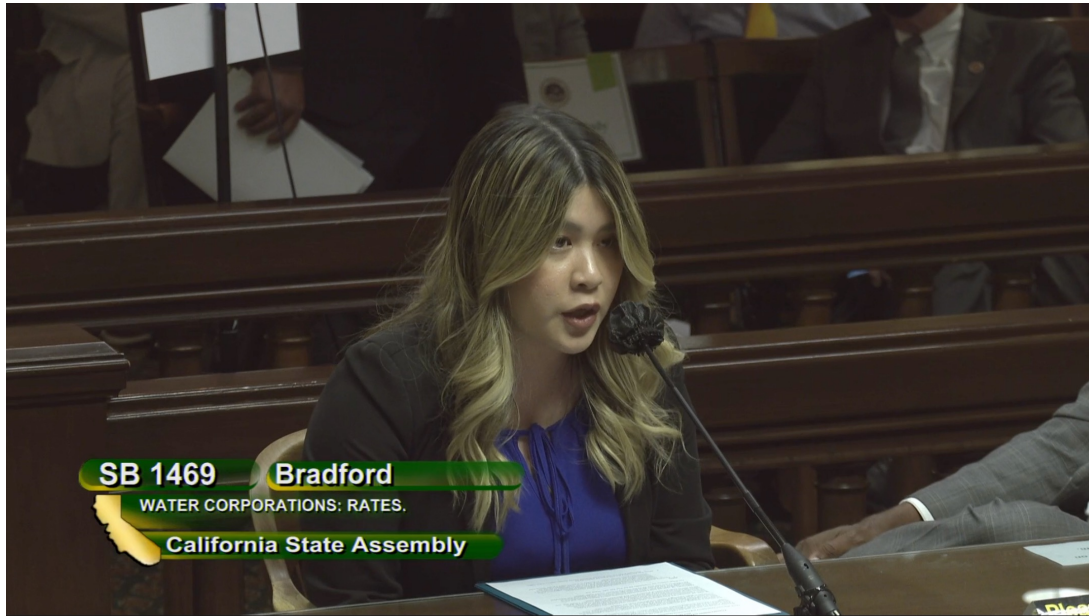
- Co-sponsoring with ACWA and WaterNow
- This bill would reinstate the California personal income tax exemption for turf replacement rebates for taxable years 2022 through 2027 to help incentivize participation in water efficiency programs.

## **Senate Bill 1157 (Hertzberg): Indoor Residential Water Standard**

- This bill will align the indoor residential water standard with the State's recommendations: 2020: 55 gpcd | 2025: 47 gpcd | 2030: 42 gpcd



# More Advocacy



## **Senate Bill 1469 (Bradford and Becker): Decoupling Water Rates**

- CalWEP Board of Directors voted to support
- This bill would direct the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to allow water companies to adjust their charges to water customers to cover costs when water conservation programs have reduced revenue and require that the charges to customers do not over collect or under collect revenue

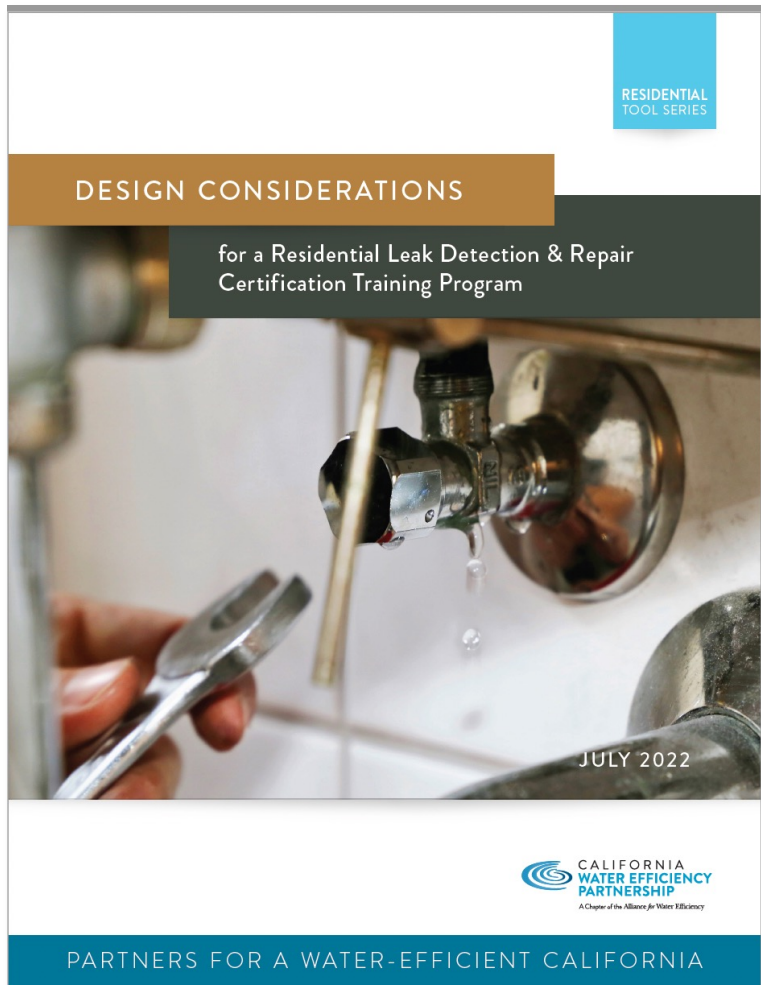

# Leak Detection & Repair



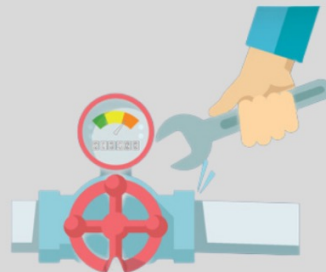
- CalWEP assisting Valley Water and BAWSCA explore feasibility of leak detection & repair certification training (indoor & outdoor modules)
